A) Focus on Training

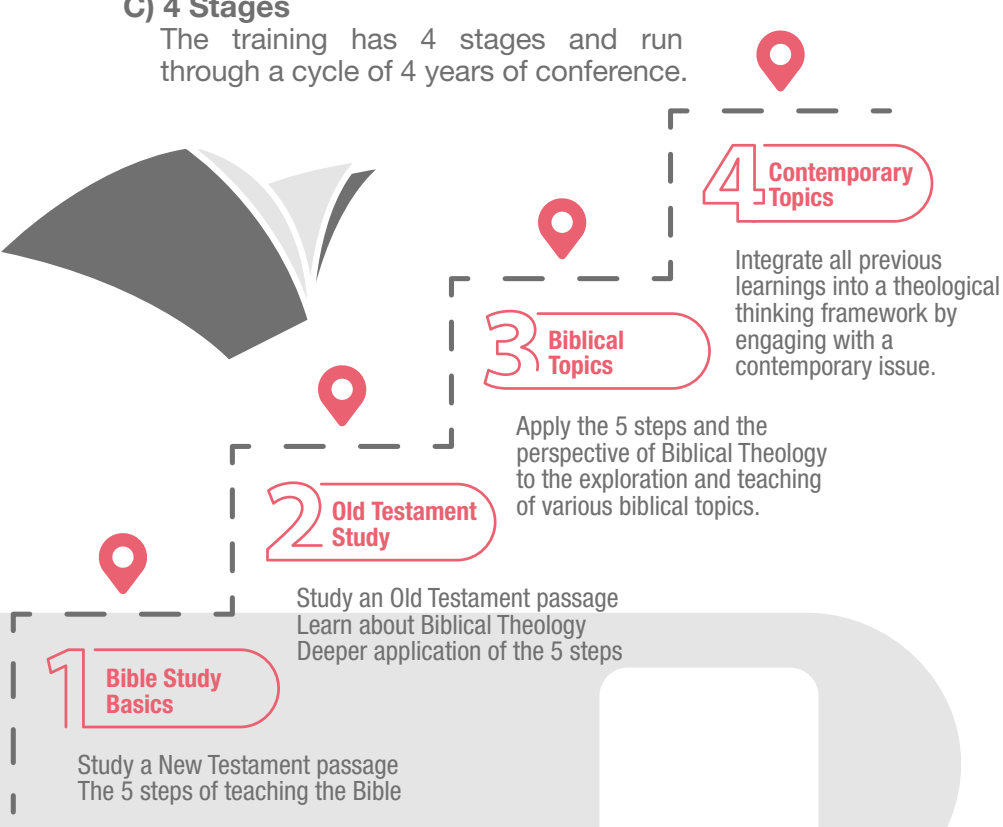

B) Interactive Learning

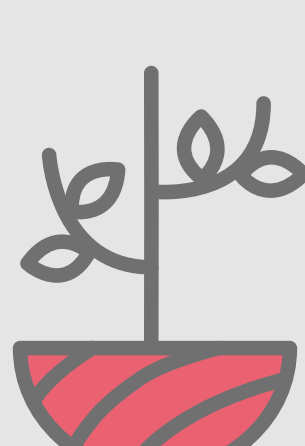
